## Message from the Principal

Dear Parents/Guardians,

As the Freshman, Sophomore, and Junior classes prepare to take the SAT suite of assessments on April 10th, I would like to take this opportunity to share with you some insight and perspective on what purposeful assessment can bring to each and every student at Fenton High School. First, we need to remember that this is a one-day summative assessment given at the beginning of April. This “summative” assessment gives us a glimpse as to the readiness of a student for college and/or the work force. What we need is perspective. Professionals in the field of education today such as Doug Reeves and Rick Stiggins have ascertained that Assessments “Of” Learning or “summative” assessments are the medical equivalent of an “autopsy” and can do little in the way of immediate intervention and feedback that our poorer performing students so desperately need. Our focus should be on Assessments “For” Learning. Assessments “For” Learning are formative in nature and are the medical equivalent of a “check up”. These assessments help us understand where a student is on a specific critical learning standard at a given point in time. Formative assessments provide the data tools needed to immediately intervene when students are not succeeding.

Recently, we have started our Communication Partnership message to families to inform and ultimately assist our students with success in their classes. This weekly message is meant to support conversations between home and school. It is not meant as a judgement. Fenton High School wants to work with all families to ensure the success of our KIDS.

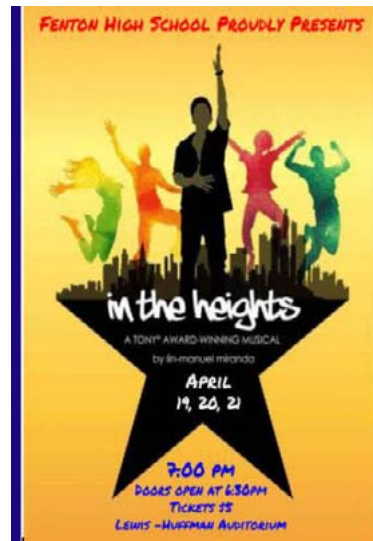

## SAT Testing - April 10

On Tuesday, April 10th, Fenton High School will be administering the SAT with writing to all juniors published by the CollegeBoard. The Illinois School Board of Education requires that this test be administered to all currently enrolled juniors and is required to graduate in the State of Illinois: it has been paid for through the District and nothing additional needs to be completed in order to register your junior students. It is important that students are in their testing rooms, ready to test at 8:00am. Once testing begins, students will not be able to enter the testing area, and they will be required to take the exam on the make-up testing day at the end of April.



April 10th is a half day for students. We will begin testing at 8:00 am, and students at all three grade levels will be dismissed at the conclusion of their exam. Freshmen and Sophomores will complete the PSAT exams at approximately 11:45 am, Juniors will complete the SAT at approximately 12:45 pm.

Seniors will not be in attendance unless they are pursuing a Seal of Biliteracy. Since Seniors have a non-attendance day, we encourage seniors to spend this day visiting a college, university, or other post-secondary program, or completing community service hours.

## Social-Emotional Learning (SEL) Parent Connection

During the month of April, Fenton's SEL program will focus on the Illinois State Standard of applying decision-making skills to deal responsibly with daily academic and social situations. Students received an organizational chart in their Google Drive SEL folder to record their current class grades and set goals for what grades they would realistically like to achieve by the end of the semester. They were then asked to brainstorm concrete steps to take to meet these goals. Please ask to see these goals and discuss them with your student. According to research, this type of activity helps students in the following ways (Hellriegel, Slocum, and Woodman & Martens, 1992 & 1987):

- Goals guide and direct students' behavior.
- Goals provide clarity for students.
- Goals help improve performance.
- Goals increase the motivation to achieve.
- Goals improve self-confidence.
- Goals help decrease negative attitudes.
- Goal-setting decreases stress, increases concentration, and seems to improve happiness.

## Fenton Water Testing Results

Fenton High School District 100 has implemented a proactive program of water testing at Fenton High School. Water sampling was conducted by an independent consulting firm.

All sampling methodology followed protocol required by The Lead in Drinking Water Testing Bill (LDWTB) an guidelines published by the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH).

Phase one was completed on February 8, while phase two was done on February 13, 2018. 104 samples were taken, and results of this testing identified one fountain with a sample higher than 20 ppb (parts per billion) which was rarely used and was taken out of service.
