## COMMUNITY

Fenton Community High School serves the residents of Bensenville, Wood Dale and a small portion of Addison. These suburban communities, situated in northeast DuPage county are located approximately 25 miles west of downtown Chicago and six miles from O'Hare International Airport.

## HIGH SCHOOL

Fenton Community High School is a four-year comprehensive high school offering academic, vocational, gifted and special education programs. Fenton has an enrollment of **1518** students. The school year is divided into two 18-week semesters. Fenton is fully accredited by the State of Illinois Board of Education.
